*The quoted tuition fee is for a unit of EFTSL=0.125. EFTSL (Equivalent Full Time Student Load) is a measure of the study load, for a year, of a student undertaking a course of study on a full-time basis. EFTSL undertaken by a regular full-time student in a year =1.00. A unit's EFTSL value is determined by calculating the unit's proportion of the annual standard full-time study load as specified in the course, e.g. if the full-time load for a course is eight (8) units of equal value per year, the EFTSL value for each unit is 1/8 = 0.125.

Note: Academic transcripts may be withheld if a student has outstanding tuition fee accounts.

**Scholarship holders are normally required to enrol as full-time students. Approval for scholarship discounts for part-time study must be sought from the Scholarship Committee prior to enrolment.
